

# Discovery Call Sample Questions

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## Sample Questions to Ask on a Discovery Call

### 1. Role & Context:

- a. What is your role and responsibility? What do you oversee?
- b. Have you heard of Entuity before?

### 2. Current Monitoring Environment:

- a. What tools are you using for monitoring today?
- b. Are you using it for just the network, or also servers, virtualization, and storage?
- c. If applicable) Which specific modules of SolarWinds (or NNMi) are you using?
- d. How are you handling monitoring currently? Is the tool administered by an in-house team, an MSP or some other situation?

### 3. Challenges with Current Tools:

- a. What challenges or pain points are you experiencing with your current tool(s)?
  - i. Are you dealing with alert fatigue or too much noise from alerts?
  - ii. What do you like or dislike about your current monitoring setup?
- b. Are there specific capabilities you wish your current tool had?
- c. Have you had any issues with support from your current vendor?

### 4. Goals & Requirements for a New Solution:

- a. Are you looking for a single pane of glass or a consolidated monitoring tool?
- b. What are the key things a new tool must be able to do for you?
- c. How important is [insert a specific capability or a couple like automated topology mapping, configuration management, NetFlow, application path monitoring, better alerting, ease of use]?

### 5. Infrastructure Details & Scope:

- a. Can you describe your environment's architecture (e.g., types of technologies / vendors used, data centers, sites, etc.)?
  - i. How many sites or locations do you have?
  - ii. Roughly how many network devices do you monitor? (e.g., switches, routers, firewalls, load balancers, wireless controllers, etc.)
  - iii. Roughly how many wireless access points do you have?
  - iv. What virtualization platforms are you using (e.g., VMware, Hyper-V, Nutanix)
  - v. Approximately how many hosts (e.g., ESXi) and VM's do you have?
  - vi. Do you have any physical/standalone servers to monitor?
  - vii. Who are your primary hardware vendors (e.g., Cisco, Arista, Palo Alto, Juniper, Dell, etc.)?
- b. What ITSM or ticketing system do you use (e.g., ServiceNow, BMC, etc.)?
- c. How many people are on the team managing this infrastructure?

### 6. Project Context & Timing:

- a. Is evaluating/replacing your monitoring tool(s) an active project currently?
- b. When is your renewal due for your current tool(s)?
- c. What does your timeline or budget cycle look like for considering a new solution?
- d. What is the decision-making process? Who else needs to be involved?

### 7. Next Steps & Scheduling:

- a. Would you be open to seeing a more detailed demo?
- b. Who else from your team should attend a demo?
- c. Is a Proof of Concept (POC) something you would typically do?
- d. Is there a good day/time next week to schedule a demo/follow up?
